TSA selection criteria – 2022 Commonwealth Games

1. Para- PTVI

- 1. Participation and top 3 SA finish at 2022 SA Invitational Para Triathlon (Maselspoort).
- 2. Participation and top 3 SA finish at 2022 SA Para Triathlon Championships.
- 3. Compliance of CG Para Triathlon Athlete Allocation Criteria (presently top 9 category ranking on WT Para Ranking as at 31 December 2021).
- 4. Merit selection (based on 3) subject to country slot allocation.

2. Other

- 1. Participation and top 5 SA finish at 2022 African Triathlon Cup Maselspoort (sprint).
- 2. Participation and top 5 SA finish at the 2022 SA Triathlon Championships (standard).
- 3. Merit selection based on the WT Ranking as at CG cut-off date, subject to country slot allocation.
- 4. Mixed Relay members will be selected from the individual selected athletes, merit based on the individual results at the CG, however team management may consider medical/technical conditions of the individual race.
- 3. In the event of a medical/technical condition in respect of 1 and/or 2, TSA in its sole discretion, may still regard the athlete eligible for selection.
- 4. If a WT points race takes place on the same weekend as 1 and/or 2, the athlete will be released from participation provided the athlete enter and participate in the WT points race.
- 5. A Junior athlete to be in contention must compete with a top 5 SA finish at the 2022 African Triathlon Cup Maselspoort **AND** achieve an outstanding time at the SA Junior Championships. Such Junior athlete(s) will be identified after the SA Junior Championships and may be requested to compete in one or more African Cup events to give a clear indication of superior performance with regards to athletes that would otherwise qualify in terms of 2.

The above constitutes the TSA selection criteria. SASCOC may apply its own selection considerations in the final selection of athletes.
